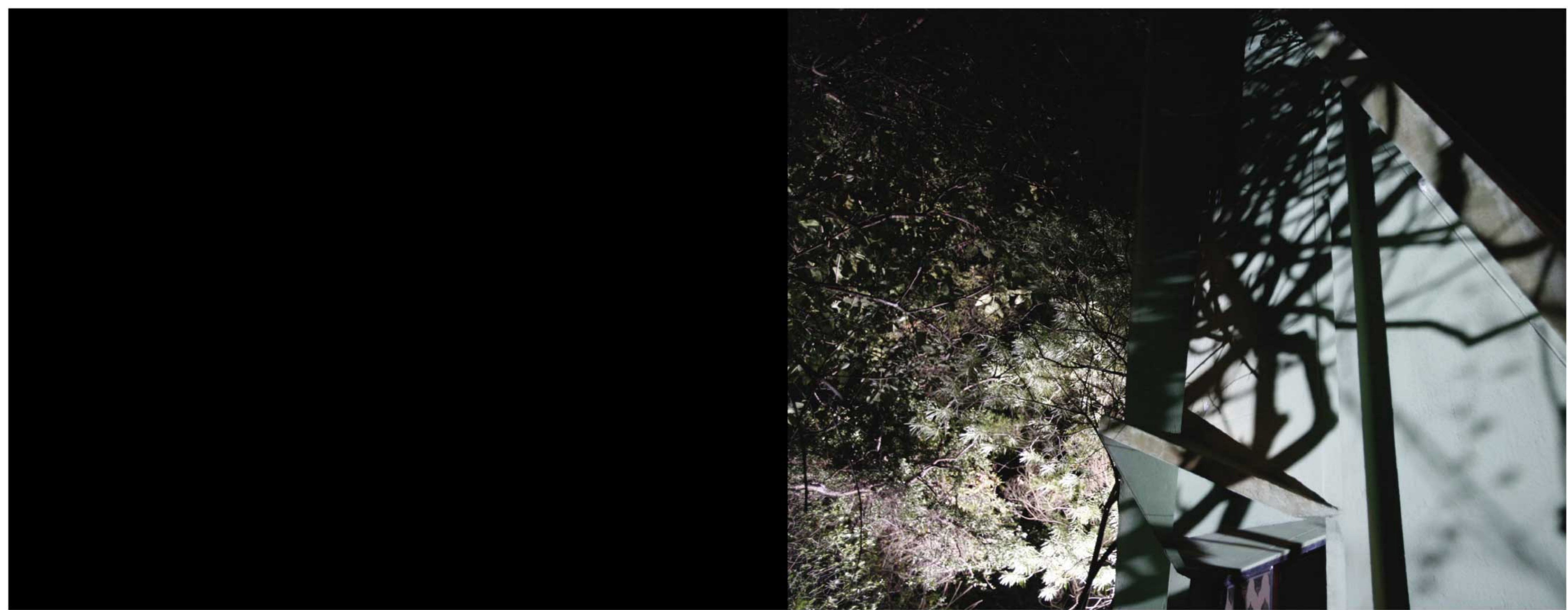

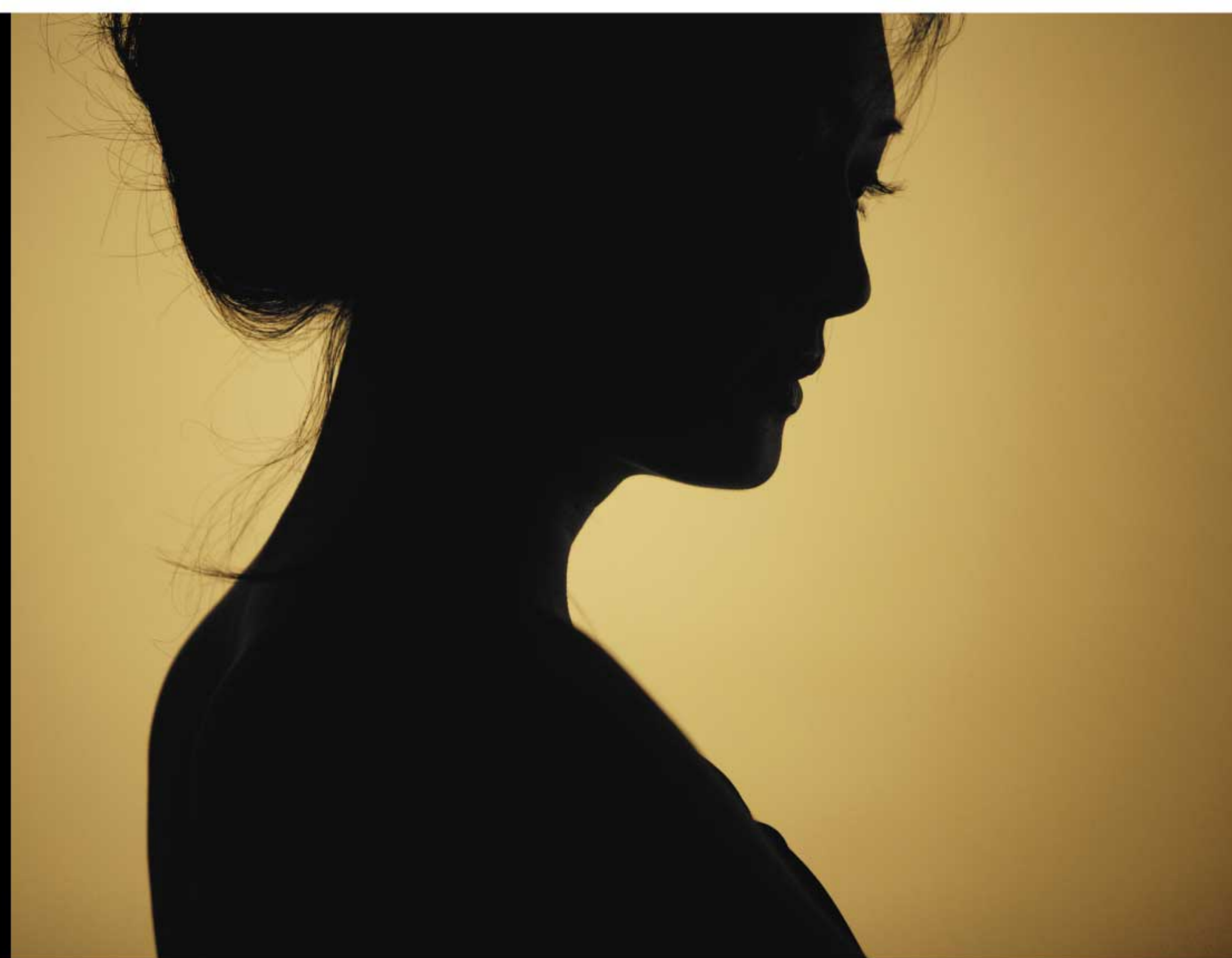

Director's Statement

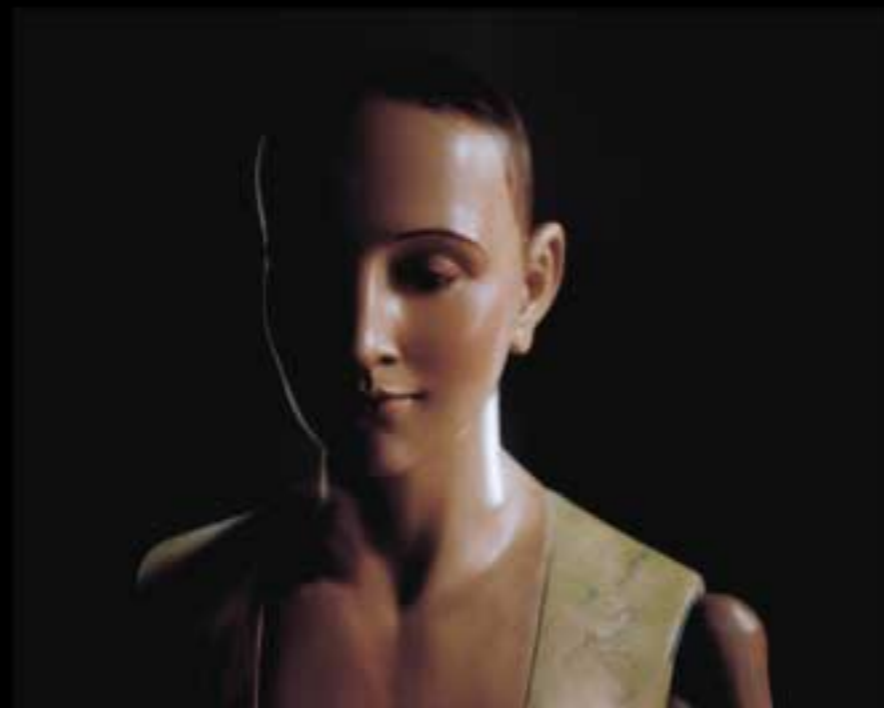

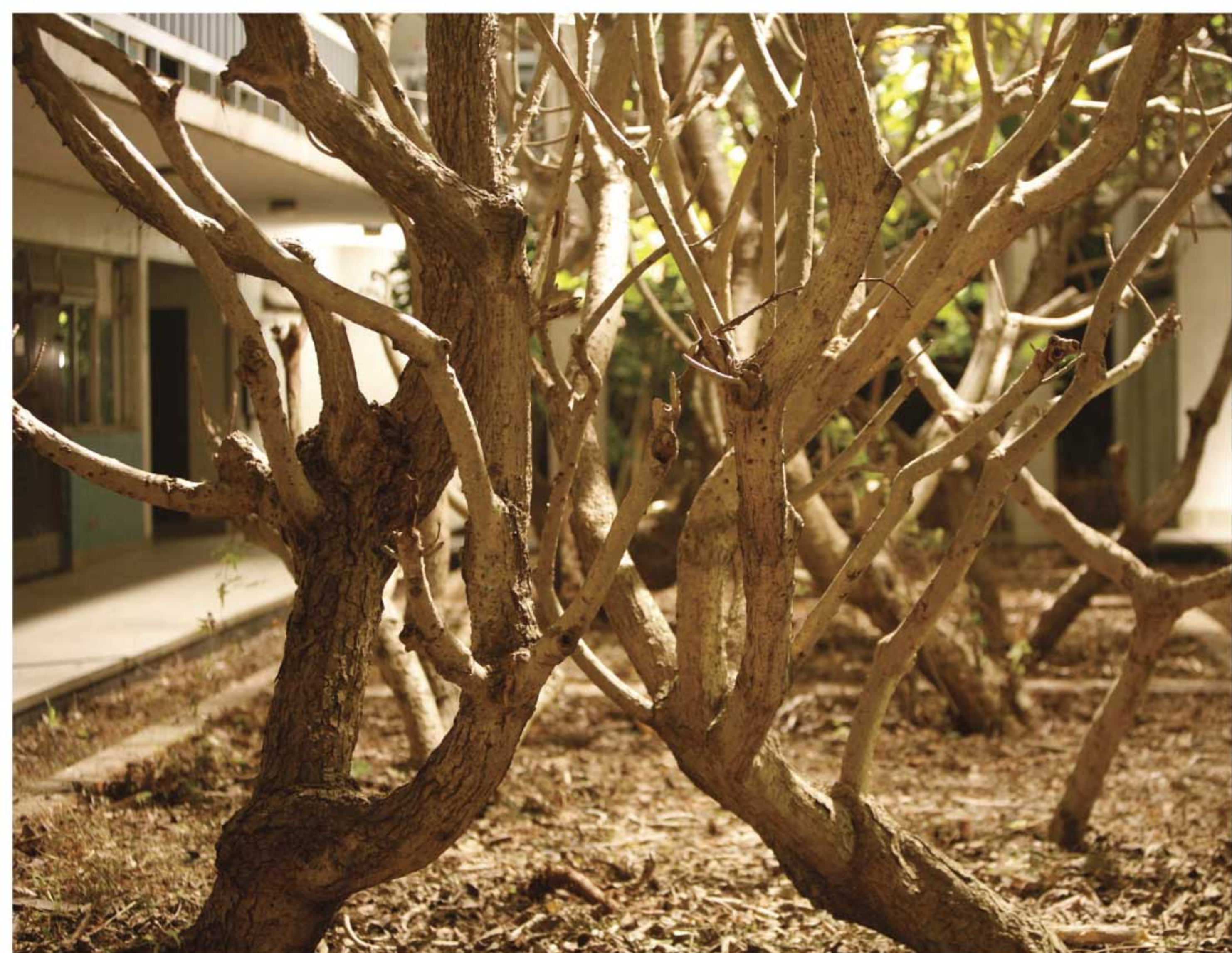
